

SECTION 9 — SPECIAL PRECAUTIONS

Precautions To Be Taken In Handling and Storage: Store and use in cool, dry, well-ventilated areas. Avoid contact with hot metal surfaces. Keep away from excessive heat or open flame. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container or store above 120°F.

Other precautions: The storage of non-flammable products with non-flammable pressurizing agent, in cartons, is the same as for ordinary canned goods in cartons. OSHA-Ceiling and ACGIH-STEL concentrations shall not be exceeded over a 15 minute exposure period up to 4 times per day. OSHA peak exposure standards of 300 ppm for Trichloroethylene and perchloroethylene shall not be exceeded for 5 minutes in any 2 hour exposure period.
